Empower Us Volunteer



We work with families within Wirral, Ellesmere Port and Neston who have a child aged 0-11 years, with additional needs.

This project offers practical and emotional support to families in a group setting. We arrange activities and events which are specifically designed for children with complex needs. Families can feel comfortable in the knowledge that they are in a welcoming and safe environment surrounded by others with similar experiences.

We want volunteers who are proactive and energetic when engaging with children, have a non-judgemental attitude towards parenting/family life, and will give a listening ear.

As a volunteer, you will support the Complex Needs Coordinator in setting up/planning activities. You will need to be physically fit and well (some children need support with mobility) and able to work as a team.

You will be able to use expressive communication, as many of the children are non-verbal or have social communication delays.

You will have a an interest in, knowledge of, or willingness to learn Makaton Signing and implement in interactions with children, and a willingness to learn Sound Listening Programme and implement in interactions with children.

You will be supported and supervised by our Complex Needs Coordinator during interactions with parents and children.
