Volunteering as a Stay and Play worker is extremely rewarding.

The sessions provided by Koala North West provide children and their parents a safe environment in which they can actively play and engage with each other, as well as with other families.



As a volunteer, you will work closely with the Early Learning Coordinator to help provide a welcoming environment for parents and their children, as well as interact and build relationships with the parents, carers and children who attend the sessions.

You would be expected to assist setting up the play area and prepare activities for the children, prepare drinks and snacks and keep facilities clean and tidy before, during and after the sessions.

You will inspire parents to become an active participant in their children's play and help them develop their child's learning and development.

You will also encourage parents to interact with each other so they can hopefully form vital peer support networks.

Your skills will include good communication and interpersonal skills and a natural flair to make people feel at ease in your company. Experience or a keen interest in children's play and working with and helping children and families is a key component in what would make a success of the role.

In return, a volunteer will develop their knowledge and skills in child development and early years and gain valuable experience of working with children and families, while working alongside a trained Early Learning Coordinator.
